Shepherd Milton Valle, is Miguel's youngest son and also his daughter-in-law Mayra are very active in the church. Miguel supervises the work in San Pedro Sula and their Shepherd Genaro & Sister Lupita, both servants with a passion to win souls for Jesus. In the city of Bonito Orienta, in the Department of Colon, he also works with Shepherd Lorenzo Guardado, where they gave a conference together. Then, in the city of Antigual del Desierto, Miguel teaches with Shepaherd Gerardo Flores in a building called the Tabernacle.
