General Information: The Tabernacle Christian School seeks born-again, competent and qualified individuals who are led of the Lord to the ministry of Christian education. TCS is a ministry of The Tabernacle Church and has been serving families in the Sarasota/Bradenton area since 1976, providing academic excellence with a Christian foundation. We are an interdenominational, nonprofit Christian school with a pre-kindergarten through eighth grade program. Our campus is located on 65 acres of beautifully landscaped property just south of University Parkway in northern Sarasota County.

Our teachers provide students excellence in academics as well as Christian values. They strive to develop the individual student's ability and talents and keep parents informed regarding student progress. Parents repeatedly tell us how much they appreciate our caring faculty.

Though spiritual enrichment occurs throughout the school day, daily Bible classes and weekly chapel services give teachers and staff concentrated times for Christian development. Teachers and staff often pray with students and regularly encourage them in their Christian walk.

Curriculum: The A Beka curriculum developed by Pensacola Christian College is the primary curriculum used at all grade levels. Academic instruction is offered in Bible, English, mathematics, science, social studies, health, and physical education. TCS also offers the following activities: computer technology, band, chorus, theatre, art, interscholastic sports, and participation in The Florida League of Christian School activities. The Tabernacle Christian School is affiliated with the Florida League of Christian Schools (FLOCS) and the Association of Christian Teachers and Schools (ACTS). The TCS Preschool is certified through the Florida League of Christian Schools (#4565).
